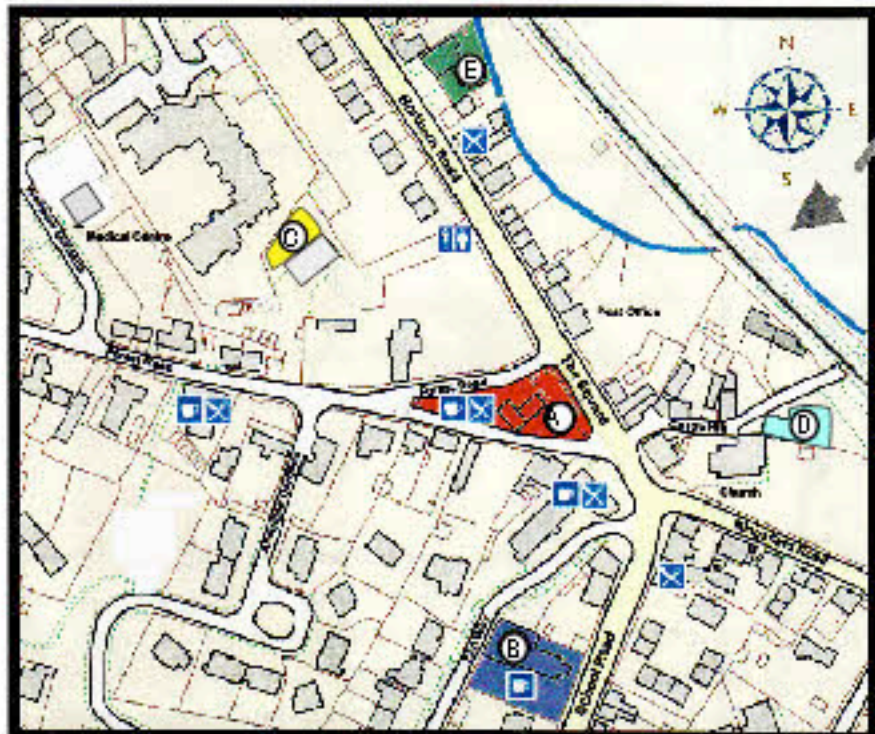
The Square (Town Centre) (A)

Public Hall (School Road) (B)

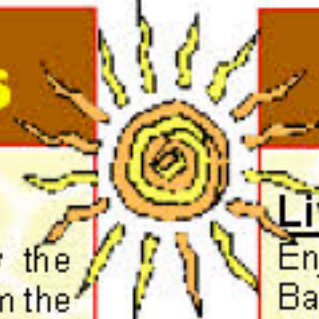
Scout Hut (Forest Road) (C)
